To whom it may concern,

Johns Manville's building insulation products (Insul-SHIELD® and AP Foil-Faced Polyisocyanurate) and formaldehyde-free fiber glass insulation products (Unfaced, Foil-Faced, FSK-25 Faced, Kraft-Faced, MR Faced, Metal Building Insulation, and ComfortTherm®) products are manufactured at a number of locations in the United States.
