GlasKap[®] CR Asphalt Bleed Out Recommendations

The use of GlasKap CR has been a big success in the California market. However some building owners are concerned about the aesthetic appearance of their GlasKap CR roofs where asphalt bleed-out is occurring and are requesting that the end and side laps be white as well.

To address this concern, JM recommends using TopGard[®] 4000 to coat the asphalt bleed out in the end and side lap areas. TopGard 4000's pigmentation has been specially formulated with stain blockers and does not require a base coat or primer before application.

TopGard 4000 can be applied the same day. Recommended application is with a 2-3" wide ½" nap roller. One application should be all that is necessary to cover the asphalt bleed out area. TopGard 4000 should not be thinned out.

For best results, wait one month before applying TopGard 4000 to the asphalt bleed out areas; however for installations that require shorter timeframes, it can be applied upon job completion or several hours after application when the asphalt has had time to harden.

Keep in mind that this is an aesthetic solution for certain roofs and not a Title 24 legislation requirement.
