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**Johns Manville Invests in Fesco®  
with New Packaging Design and Equipment**

As part of Johns Manville's commitment to improve our signature Fesco Cover Board portfolio, we are proud to announce the completion of a major capital-equipment expansion at our Rockdale, Illinois manufacturing facility.

Over the last year, our operational team has developed a shrink-wrap package to better protect each pallet. JM partnered with Moellers North American, Inc. to develop automated equipment to ensure reliable and consistent packaging. With a short transition time to turn existing inventories, the new packaging should be fully implemented into the market by the end of March.



**Considerations:** Despite the improved packaging, Fesco products should never be left exposed to the weather. The new packaging is intended to temporarily protect the Fesco while in transit; truck loads will still be covered with a tarpaulin. At the job site, the Fesco product must be stored in accordance with Johns Manville and NRCA (National Roofing Contractors Association) best roofing practices using a weatherproof covering such as a tarpaulin. In humid climates, JM recommends slitting the plastic shrink wrap, prior to covering the pallet with a tarpaulin, to allow for venting. The new factory packaging should not be relied upon as protection from the weather.
