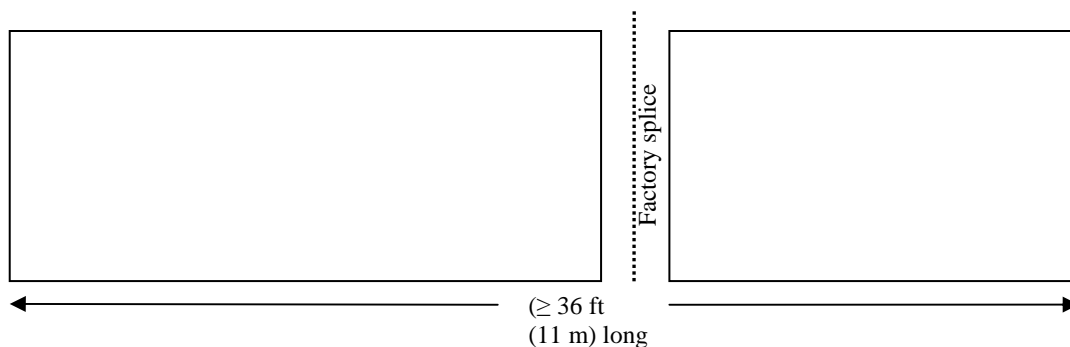
**Johns Manville Roofing Environmental Stewardship  
Waste Reduction Plan**

One of Johns Manville's fundamental corporate pillars is environmental respect. Our focus on sustainability will help ensure constant attention to reducing the environmental effects of our processes and operations. In roofing, that translates into utilizing as much good product as possible during the manufacturing and finishing process to avoid sending excessive scrap material to the landfill.

Effective immediately, Johns Manville is reinstating the practice of shipping two-piece modified bitumen rolled goods. Two-piece rolls will now utilize the remaining good product after the factory splice has been removed. This practice will save approximately 170 tons of good material being sent to the landfill annually. The SBS and APP plants participating include Macon, Georgia; Plattsburgh, New York; and South Gate, California.

Each pallet will contain no more than one two-piece roll and each truck will not typically have more than one pallet with a two-piece roll. Each two-piece roll will be marked with a sticker indicator.

Each two-piece roll provides at least 3 feet (1 m) of additional (free) material compared to a traditional roll (33-feet long). Each two-piece section is no less than 10 feet (3 m) long.
